**ORDINANCE NO.: 2018-4**

**TOWN OF RED CEDAR  
ORDINANCE TO LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON 410<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE**

The Town Board of the Town of Red Cedar, Dunn County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limit on certain town highways as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., effective June 20, 2018, speed limits on certain Town of Red Cedar town highways are reduced or modified as follows: the Town of Red Cedar portion of 410<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Ball Diamond Road) between County Road J and County Road Y, from 55 mph to 45 mph.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11(5), Wis. Stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under 346.60, Wis. Stats.

This ordinance is effective on June 20, 2018.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
